

Key West Writers Guild Award

A grant program of the Florida Keys Council of the Arts

\$2,000 Award

The purpose of the award is to enable a talented writer who is a resident of Monroe County to complete a novel or a non-fiction work.

1. Application guidelines

1. Submit a one-page cover letter that includes a description of the project, the author's goals for the work, and how he/she will go about creating it.

Submit four (4) copies of a manuscript excerpt 30 - 50 pages. Manuscripts must be double-spaced and in 12-point type. The author's name, phone, mailing address, and email address may appear only on the cover letter and application. No personal information should appear anywhere on the manuscript. Manuscripts will not be returned.
Submit Monroe County residency such as a copy of a driver's license or utility bill.
The applicant must be a current member of the Key West Writers Guild and must have read from the manuscript during at least two Guild meetings during the six months preceding the deadline.

 5. Application deadline is: Friday, April 12, 2019 at Florida Keys Council of the Arts -1100 Simonton St. Key West OR Saturday, April 13, 2019 at the KW Writers Guild Meeting held at Key West by the Sea, 2601 S. Roosevelt Blvd, Community Room.
6. The winner will be announced on May 11 or 25, 2019 at the regular Key West Writers Guild meeting.

The award will be distributed in two parts — \$1,000 upon announcement of the winner and \$1,000 the following year after the author's satisfactory status report to the Florida Keys Council of the Arts. This award must be appropriately acknowledged in the finished manuscript and all editions of the published book.

The Key West Writers Guild Award is supported by private funds and is administered by the Florida Keys Council of the Arts.
