Instructions for all Grant Applicants

The original and one photocopy of the entire application including questions is to be received by

The completed application consists of the attached 2-page application and a narrative answering the questions on this page. Please answer all questions completely with as much detail as possible. Please type or print legibly. Late, incomplete or illegible applications will not be considered.

Examples of your work may be submitted in photo form. Please limit to 5 photographs. Samples will not be returned.

The following questions are required to be completed in detail for a complete application.

- 1. **Provide a brief narrative account of your career** describing your previous accomplishments. This account should include prizes, honors and grants or fellowships that you have received showing grantor and the inclusive dates of each award. We are also interested in contributions made to the Key West cultural community and non-profit organizations.
- 2. List of the following as applicable to your field.
 - a. **Writers** include give titles, names of publishers and dates and places of publications. Playwrights should include list of productions.
 - b. **Visual artists**, include a chronological list of shows, citing dates and places and a list of collections in which your work is represented. Forthcoming shows should also be listed.
 - c. **Composers and Song writers**, include a chronological list of your compositions, citing titles and dates, a list of your published compositions, citing the names of publishers and the dates of publication and a list of recordings.
 - d. **Performing Artists** including musicians, actors, dancers, include a chronological list of performances, contests, auditions, awards and scholarships received, citing dates and places. Include your performance ready repertoire as well as works in progress.
 - e. **Filmmakers** and Videographers, include a chronological list of your works, citing titles, dates of completion and dates and places of public showings of each.
- 3. **Description of Project**: Provide a complete description of the project for which the grant is requested and a statement of how it will be implemented. Include how it will benefit your career and/or the community.
- 4. **Grant Budget**: Please be very specific in how the grant monies you are requesting will be utilized or spent. Salary and living expenses are not acceptable.
- 5. **Demonstration of need**: Please provide a statement on why you need the grant, financial need and/or recognition for career advancement. How will the grant benefit your career and/or the community at large?
